Bulgarian Air Charter selects navAero t•BagC2² for MD-82 EFB Program Hardware

APRIL 13, 2009 Sundsvall, Sweden — navAero t•BagC2² computer and display hardware has been chosen as the Class 2 EFB flight deck hardware by Bulgarian Air Charter. The carrier will equip their entire McDonnell Douglas MD-82 fleet, becoming the second European MD-82 operator to select navAero to fulfill their EFB requirements.

Bulgarian Air Charter made the choice for the navAero Class 2 EFB solution for the superior operational functionalities and substantial retrofit cost savings they will realize through the deployment of t•BagC2² hardware technology.
