**Freebird Airline selects navAero t•BagC2²
for A320 / A321 Class 2 EFB Program Hardware**

FEBRUARY 22, 2008 Sundsvall, Sweden — The navAero t•BagC2² computer and display hardware has been chosen as the EFB flight deck hardware by Freebird Airlines to equip the carrier's A320 and A321 fleets.

Freebird made the choice for the navAero Class 2 EFB solution for the superior operational functionalities and retrofit cost savings they will realize through the deployment of t•BagC2² hardware technology.

Freebird Chief Engineer Caglar Ak said: "Our decision to select the navAero Class 2 EFB solution will give Freebird a cost-effective platform. The technological advances of computer information delivery and management of the airplane flight deck will provide enhanced operational solutions such as accurate performance calculations and significant savings of time for managing information in the air and on the ground."

Dual networked installations of the navAero t•BagC2² hardware systems – featuring built-in HSDPA/UMTS/GRPS/EDGE and WiFi connectivity – will be installed on the A320 and A321 flightdecks. Certification for these airframes is being executed by navAero. As a Class II device, the navAero t•BagTMC2² system is suitable for use during all phases of flight.

Deployments on Freebird fleets will start during calendar year 2008. Flying trials are scheduled to commence in Q2 2008, and it is anticipated that these fleets will be fully deployed and operational by early 2009.
